## FOR THE EXPORT OF AGRICULTURAL COMMODITIES.

- 1. All Exporters must register with the National Plant Protection Organisation (NPPO) Guyana.
- 2. An Import Permit issued by the Importing Country (if required) and any other supporting documents must be presented to the Quarantine Officer.
- 3. The export documents (export licence) obtained from the office of Ministry of Trade and Commerce and/or the C72 Customs documents from the Guyana Revenue Authority is submitted to the NPPO for approval/certification (approval stamp and signature) for the export of the indicated agricultural commodity; ( NOTE: the stamping of this document does not constitute Quarantine's authorization to export).
- 4. Exports of fresh fruits and vegetables must be processed at the New Guyana Marketing Corporation (NGMC) packing facilities located at Sophia or Parika or any approved packing facilities.
- 5. Export of Rice, rice products, sugar and sugar products will be processed at the various mills, wharves and container terminals.
- 6. A formal request for Quarantine Inspection Services should be made seventy- two hours (72 hrs) prior to the proposed shipping date of all Agricultural Commodities and Regulated Articles.
- 7. A visual Phytosanitary Inspection and Certification of commodity is done by Quarantine Inspectors of the NPPO, Guyana;
- 8. A Phytosanitary Certificate is issued to validate the consignment, once all Phytosanitary conditions for export are met.
- 9. The commodity/ shipment is released for export.
